

DIY CRAFT PROJECT

Egg Carton Caterpillar

Level: Beginner

Create creepy-crawly caterpillars that are egg-ceptionally fun and easy!

What you need:

Cardboard Egg Carton

Elmer's Glue All

EDUcraft Pipe Cleaners

EDUcraft Joggle Eyes

Jasart Creativity Paper

Reeves Acrylic Paint 75ml in your choice of colours

Paint Brush

Scissors

Marker



What you do:

- 1. Cut off the lid from the egg carton. Use the bottom section of the egg carton for this project.
- 2. Cut the bottom section of the egg carton in half lengthwise.
- 3. Cut off the lip of the egg carton if necessary so that the edges are even all of the way around.
- 4. Paint the egg carton in bright colours. Add spots and stripes to make the caterpillar unique and realistic. Let the paint dry completely.
- 5. Glue two EDUcraft Joggle Eyes to one end of the egg carton.
- 6. Draw a mouth with markers.
- 7. Cut a sheet of Creativity Paper into six strips to make legs.
- 8. Make sure each strip is slightly longer than the width of the egg carton so it sticks out on both sides of it.
- 9. Turn over the egg carton and glue the strips to the separators between each section. Let the Elmer's Glue All dry completely.
- 10. Turn over the caterpillar and poke pipe cleaners into the top of the front section for antennae.
